

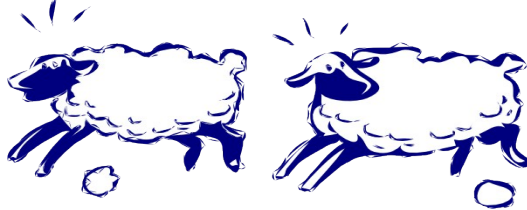
Long vowel patterns

l & o can be long when followed by two consonants

long ō: Put a **coat** on to **go** home in the **cold snow**.
